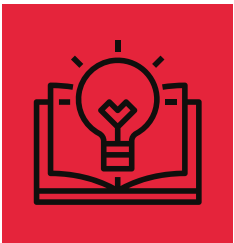

OUR MISSION

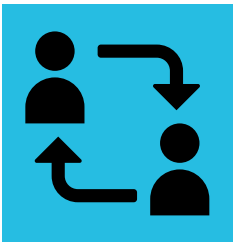
